2 Types of Limits OneSided Limits We look at what happens as x approaches a from the left using the minus sign or from the right using the plus sign TwoSided Limits If both the lefthand and righthand limits exist and are equal then the twosided limit exists

3 Continuity Smooth Sailing A function is continuous at a point if its graph can be drawn without lifting your pen A function is continuous on an interval if its continuous at every point in that interval

2 Key Idea For a function to be continuous at a point three things need to be true The function must be defined at that point The limit of the function as x approaches that point must exist The value of the function at that point must be equal to the limit

4 Techniques for Finding Limits Direct Substitution If the function is defined and continuous at the point simply plug in the value Factoring and Simplifying Look for common factors that can be cancelled Rationalizing the Numerator or Denominator Multiply by a clever form of 1 to simplify the expression Squeezing Theorem If we can squeeze a function between two other functions that have the same limit then our function also has that limit LHopitals Rule For indeterminate forms like $0/0$ or ∞/∞ we can differentiate the numerator and denominator and take the limit again

5 Continuity and Discontinuities Removable Discontinuities These occur when theres a hole in the graph that can be filled by redefining the function at that point Jump Discontinuities The
