screen savors studies how the self of whites is imagined in hollywood movies by white directors featuring white protagonists interacting with people of another color this collaboration by a sociologist and a film critic using the new perspective of critical white studies offers a bold and sweeping critique of almost a century s worth of american film from birth of nation 1915 through black hawk down 2001 screen savors studies the way in which the social relations that we call race are fictionalized and pictured in the movies it argues that films are part of broader projects that lead us to ignore or deny the nature of the racial divide in which americans live even as the images of racial and ethnic minorities change across the twentieth century hollywood keeps
