as france s oldest team sport rugby football has throughout its 125 year history reflected major changes in french society this book analyzes for the first time the complex variety of motives that have led the french to adopt and remake this rather unlikely british sport in their own image a major site for the construction of masculine class based regional and national identities france s tradition of champagne rugby continues to be as subject to dramatic upheavals as the society that produced it the game s precocious professionalism and endemic violence have not infrequently caused the french to be cast as international pariahs such isolation exacerbated by internal politics has led the french not only to encourage the extension of the sport beyond its british imperial base into italy and romania for instance but also to engage in some uncomfortable tactical alliances most obviously with apartheid south africa taking his analysis both on and off the field the author tackles these issues and much more the relationship of sport and the state including particularly the vichy period and the period under de gaulle professionalization the persistence of colonial and postcolonial structures including the role of ethnic minorities and gender issues especially masculine identities at the same time he links the evolution of the sport to the broader context of french socio economic political and cultural history this book will be essential reading for anyone interested in the cultural analysis of sport or french popular culture

L'auteur de ce nouveau guide est né en 1930, c'est-à-dire qu'il a connu l'occupation autrement que par ouï-dire ou au travers des livres : il a assisté, le cœur serré, à l'entrée de l'armée allemande en Bretagne le 18 juin 1940 et il a échappé de peu quatre ans plus tard aux bombes anglo-américaines. Entre temps, vivant dans un milieu familial et relationnel plus sensible aux appels de Londres qu'à ceux de Vichy et complètement sourd à ceux de Berlin ou de Paris, il a souvent tracé des croix de Lorraine sur le tableau noir de sa classe. Il se souvient d'avoir assisté à une manifestation anti-allemande le 14 juillet 1941, avant d'entrer peu après dans le mouvement scout de France, alors clandestin. Il a lu à l'époque quelques-uns des auteurs cités : le colonel Alerme, René Benjamin, Serge Dalens, Roger Lefèvre et son inoubliable *Raz de marée*, Pierre Mariage et sa passion des équipages et d'autres encore. Sans oublier le maréchal et ses maximes et principes, universitaire, auteur d'une thèse sur le parlement de Bretagne à la fin du xvi^e siècle et de divers travaux consacrés à l'histoire du droit français public et privé. Ch. A. Cardot a consacré les premières années de sa retraite à l'élaboration d'un ouvrage conçu comme un instrument de travail pour les historiens et pour les libraires, mais qui est aussi destiné à tous ceux qui par-delà les partis pris veulent découvrir dans toute sa complexité le visage de la France pendant l'occupation.

Most people think that England's last war with France involved point-blank broadsides from sailing ships and breastplated Napoleonic cavalry charging red-coated British infantry. But there was a much more recent conflict than this. It went on for over two years and cost several thousand lives. Under the terms of its armistice with Nazi Germany, the unoccupied part of France and its substantial colonies were ruled from the spa town of Vichy by the government of Marshal Philip Pétain, the victor of Verdun. One of the bloodiest battles of the First World War between July 1940 and November 1942, while Britain was at war with Germany, Italy, and ultimately Japan, it also fought land, sea, and air battles with the considerable forces at the disposal of Pétain's Vichy French. When the Royal Navy sank the French fleet at Mers el Kebir, almost 1,300 French sailors died in what was the 20th century's most one-sided sea battle. British casualties were nil. In the House of Commons, MPs greeted Churchill's brutal resolve not to risk the warships of their very recent ally falling into German hands with cheers and threw their order papers in the air. It is a wound that has still not healed. For undoubtedly

these events are better remembered in france than in britain despite the appalling losses on both sides the war the british and eventually the americans fought against france in 1940 42 has never been written about as an entity an embarrassment at the time its maritime massacre and the bitter hard fought campaigns that followed rarely make more than footnotes in accounts of allied operations against axis forces until now
