written under the direction of John F. McGowan with the assistance of Thomas I. Porter. The revision attempts to incorporate suggestions received from state training supervisors who have used the original publication. Major sections are: 1. Introduction and background which includes basic concepts of vocational rehabilitation, related legislation, and the locating of persons who need help; 2. Preliminary study and planning which includes initiating the rehabilitation process, determining eligibility, and making a medical, psychological, sociocultural, and vocational assessment of the client; 3. Client services which includes planning, services, providing prevocational and rehabilitational counseling, and locating places of employment; and 4. The rehabilitation counselor's role. Suggested readings are included at the end of each section, and several client study case abstracts are appended.

Presents a general survey on the vocational rehabilitation and employment of disabled persons. Convention 1983, No. 159, and Recommendation No. 168 define key terms and expressions of the instruments and describe the provisions within the standards and the relevant national legislation in the countries that have ratified this convention. Considers vocational rehabilitation from the standpoint of social security schemes, discusses member states' obligations to implement national policy on vocational rehabilitation, the means by which national policy can be developed, and difficulties encountered by member states in the application of the instruments.

Considers § 1525 to extend and expand vocational rehabilitation services by authorizing federal grants for training programs and construction of rehabilitation facilities and by encouraging increased participation in rehabilitation services by mentally retarded and other handicapped individuals.
