cultures drawing on extensive archival research brandt demonstrates that women healers were not inflexible traditional practitioners destined to fall victim to the onward march of enlightenment science capitalism and medical professionalization instead women of various classes and ethnicities found new sources of healing authority engaged in the consumer medical marketplace and resisted physicians attempts to marginalize them brandt reveals that women healers participated actively in medical and scientific knowledge production and the transition to market capitalism
