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for two centuries gesamtkunstwerk the ideal of the total work of art has exerted a powerful influence over artistic discourse and practice spurring new forms of collaboration and provoking debates over the political instrumentalization of art despite its popular conflation with the work of richard wagner gesamtkunstwerk s lineage and legacies extend well beyond german romanticism as this wide ranging collection demonstrates in eleven compact chapters scholars from a variety of disciplines trace the idea s evolution in german speaking europe from its foundations in the early nineteenth century to its manifold articulations and reimaginings in the twentieth century and beyond providing an uncommonly broad perspective on a distinctly modern cultural form

in this groundbreaking book david roberts sets out to demonstrate the centrality of the total work of art to european modernism since the french revolution the total work of art is usually understood as the intention to reunite the arts into the one integrated whole but it is also tied from the beginning to the desire to recover and renew the public function of art the synthesis of the arts in the service of social and cultural regeneration was a particularly german dream which made wagner and nietzsche the other center of aesthetic modernism alongside baudelaire and mallarmé the history and theory of the total work of art pose a whole series of questions not only to aesthetic modernism and its utopias but also to the whole epoch from the french revolution to the totalitarian revolutions of the twentieth century the total work of art indicates the need to revisit key assumptions of modernism such as the foregrounding of the autonomy and separation of the arts at the expense of the countertendencies to the reunion of the arts and cuts across the neat equation of avant gardism with progress and deconstructs the familiar left right divide between revolution and reaction the modern and the antimodern situated at the interface between art religion and politics the total work of art invites us to rethink the relationship between art and religion and art and politics in european modernism in a major departure from the existing literature david roberts argues for twin lineages of the total work a french revolutionary and a german aesthetic which interrelate across the whole epoch of european modernism culminating in the aesthetic and political radicalism of the avant garde movements in response to the crisis of autonomous art and the accelerating political crisis of european societies from the 1890s forward

this book explores the widespread fascination with world creation among early twentieth century artists and examines those trends within the european avant garde the

book reflects on what the world looks and feels like before and after world war one and thus also concerns creativity and destruction alike in the context of modernity over the course of three chapters the author focusses on works in which avant garde artists combine and experiment with various arts and media to create alternative narratives of the world s creation these works include three canonized total works of art der weltbaumeister the world s master builder 1920 an illustrated book imagined as an architectural play by the expressionist architect bruno taut the futurist opera *Победа над солнцем* victory over the sun 1913 by aleksei kruchenykh velimir khlebnikov kazimir malevich and mikhail matiushin and the cubist ballet la création du monde the creation of the world 1923 by blaise cendrars fernand léger darius milhaud and jean börlin providing new readings of these classic works that dive deeply into the avant garde s inter artistic search for new modes of mediation as well as its dialogue with science politics and technology abigael van alst demonstrates how each of these artworks staged a cosmogony an alternative story of the universe s creation which simultaneously experimentally and critically recounted the story of modernity this new book is ideal for researchers and scholars in history of art modernism and comparative literature

should sight trump the other four senses when experiencing and evaluating art art history and the senses 1830 to the present questions whether the authority of the visual in visual culture should be deconstructed and focuses on the roles of touch taste smell and sound in the materiality of works of art from the nineteenth century onward notions of synaesthesia and the multi sensorial were important to a series of art movements from symbolism to futurism and installations the essays in this collection evaluate works of art at specific moments in their history and consider how senses other than the visual have or have not affected the works meaning the result is a re evaluation of sensory knowledge and experience in the arts encouraging a new level of engagement with ideas of style and form

providing a fresh perspective on an important but underappreciated group of late nineteenth century french painters this is the first book to provide an in depth account of the nabis practice of the decorative and its significance for twentieth century modernism over the course of the ten years that define the nabi movement 1890 1900 its principal artists included edouard vuillard pierre bonnard maurice denis paul s sier and paul ranson the author reconstructs the nabis relationship to impressionism mass culture literary symbolism art nouveau wagnerianism and a revolutionary artistic tradition in order to show how their painterly practice emerges out of the pressing questions defining modernism around 1900 she shows that the nabis were engaged nonetheless with issues that are always at stake in accounts of nineteenth century modernist painting issues such as the relationship of high and low art of individual sensibility and collective identity of the public and private spheres the nabis and intimate modernism is a rigorous study of the intellectual and artistic endeavors that inform the nabis decorative domestic paintings in the 1890s and argues for their

centrality to painterly modernism the book ends up not only re positioning the nabis to occupy a crucial place in modernism s development from 1860 to 1914 but also challenges that narrative to place more emphasis on notions of decoration totality and interiority

in western european culture during the middle ages and early modern period artists from various disciplines collaborated frequently and produced amazingly complex multi media art works the contributions to this volume in the series groningen studies in cultural change take up the challenge to go beyond comparatism in order to study combinations of the arts in the most literal sense of the word and explore the changing attitudes towards the production and perception of multi media art from the middle ages to the early modern period the topics range from the epistemology of word and image combined multi media interior decoration early forms of totaltheater political communication the emotive effects of lutherian poetry and music to the eighteenth century french critics of ut pictura poesis

the total work of art provides a broad survey that incorporates many canonical artists into a single narrative with particular attention to the influence of the total work of art on modern theatre and performance this brief introduction will also be of interest to students in such fields as film studies music history history of art cultural studies and modern european literatures

lothar hempel's elaborate installations of freestanding architectural features and full sized figures have as much in common with theatrical productions as with most artworks his scenes confront the viewer with open ended dramas and ideological dilemmas his paintings and puppet like characters exist as potential casts for these scenarios like brecht or beckett hempel born in cologne in 1966 isn't looking to provoke emotional engagement so much as the viewer's critical reaction to the idea of

narrative the ideology of storytelling with a designer s elegance he combines aesthetics from the past and the present quoting medieval tapestries and early modernism in work infused with a sense of tragedy mythology and burlesque the work gathered here has been shown in museums in both the u s and europe and at new york galleries including anton kern 2006 this is hempel s first major monograph
