turkish nationalism and western civilization 1959 presents ziya gökalp s synthesis of nationalism islam and western civilization in a developmental and systematic way more than as a sociologist poet man of public affairs or ideological slogan maker ziya gökalp 1876 1924 deserves the attention of social
